“Help me Grow” is the need of the hour, for the proper growth and development of a pre-scholar. It does not for any special technique or skills-just a few minutes out of your busy schedule will work wonders for your CHILD. In this competitive world you can give a few minutes to your child and help him grow into a positive individual with a balanced mind, high emotional security, good communicative skill articulate and above all a confident child with good ethical values. A Number of activities are given below for reinforcement. These activities are carried out in classes —but reinforcement of these activities are essential for the positive growth of a child.

Basic Manner —Teach your child to wish the elders-

Good Morning, Good Night etc.

Five Golden Words — Introduces the 5 golden words; Please, Sorry, Thank you, Excuse me and May I, in sentences in different situations, everyday.

Sharing the Load — Have your child help you in some way as you work inside and outside the house. You might ask him/her to sweep the floor separate trash, or feed pets or put things in order.

Look and Remember —Place few fruits and vegetables and fruits on a tray. Let your child see and observe them for a minute. Then cover the tray with a piece of cloth.

Now ask your child to name as many fruits and vegetables as he remembers.

Help me Grow

2. July to August :

Familiar Places — Take your child for a drive. On the way show him some specific spots e.g. pizza shop, fire station etc. while coming back on the same road, ask your child to recollect and identify the spots.

How old are you? — Help your child string beads on strong thread Ask your child to show with beads how old he/she is now. Then ask your child to show how old he/she will be on his/her next birthday.

Hold a competition —

- (i) To tie laces of 2 pairs of shoes in a given time.
- (ii) Ask the child to select his favorite corner or room in the house and decorate it.

3. September

Telephone manners — Teach your child and how to answer the phone calls. Let him/her make a few call to wish relative a “Happy Birthday” and “Happy Anniversary”.

Bounce and Catch — Show your child how to bounce a ball and catch it at waist level. Be sure the ball is large enough for your child to catch easily.

Reading Time — Reading a new story to your child. Ask him/her questions when you finish.

E.g. How do you think Felt when ?
How would you feel if you were

Switch on a cassette of nursery rhymes and ask the child to listen to it at least for two days. Ask him/her to recite as many rhymes as he can recollect.

Jigsaw Puzzle — Ask your child to assemble the various pieces of a jigsaw puzzle.

4. October and November

Go out to a restaurant — Take your child out for lunch/dinner. Let your child place an order for himself

/herself, whatever he/she would like to eat or drink.

Play time —Give your child to give some your clothes to wear for play. Encourage him/her to dress up in some of the clothing and pretend to be different characters.

Exercise —See how many ways you and your child can move your arms and legs and still remain in the same place. Begin by lying on your back and moving your arms and legs in different ways.

Animals Sound —Record 10 animals sounds in cassette, play it and ask the child the to identify the sounds and name the particular animals.

Tunnel Balls —Stand about 6 feet from each other form your legs spread apart. Practice rolling a ball through each other's legs.

Remember —Show your child some of his/her baby pictures. Please them in order of age. Talk together about how your child has grown and changed.

Sounds around us — See of your child can make the sounds of thunder, aeroplane, Ambulance, Engine etc.

December to January

Take a Walk with your child. Ask him/her to count the number of trees or 4 legged animals etc.

February to March

Memory Game —Speak out 20words such as train, cat, hospital, balloon, school, garden etc. To your child in one minute. Then ask your child to recollect as many words as he can.

Walk And Look — Take a walk with your child. Ask your child to name all the creatures he/she can see that his four or two legs. On your way back coollect leaves, flowers, pebbles etc.

Germination — Sow a seed in your garden. Ask your child to water the plant as it grows and observe it regularly.

Rhyming Words — Say any words e.g. Moon. Now ask your child to give you another word which sounds the same like noon, soon etc.
